

Covid-19 Hygiene Update for Bridal Hair & Makeup Trials.

The following measures are being put into place to protect clients' health & safety during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Prior to the appointment

If you or anyone you have come into close contact with has symptoms of Covid-19 including but not limited to a sore throat, cough, temperature, loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath then please reschedule your appointment with me, this will come at no extra cost to you.

If you or anyone you have come into close contact with has recently travelled abroad to any of the countries not listed within the UK travel corridor please allow a 14-day quarantine period before visiting me for your trial.

Where possible please avoid using public transport to visit me.

Please ensure your hair is washed within 24 hours of your appointment.

For the foreseeable future I will not be visiting clients homes, all trial appointments will be held at my home in Hertfordshire that will be cleaned and well ventilated prior to your arrival.

Please attend your trial appointment alone. If another member of your bridal party would like a trial with me they will need to book a separate appointment.

I will take my temperature prior to the appointment and will take your temperature on arrival, so that we can keep each other safe.

Do forward hair, makeup and any other relevant visuals to me ahead of your appointment via Pinterest, Whatsapp, Text message or Email and ideally leave your mobile phone in your bag inside the door upon arrival.

My workplace strategy

Trials will take place in a well-ventilated room.

If possible please minimise what you bring along with you i.e. jewellery, scarves, handbags. Please leave any necessary jackets, bags and shoes inside the door and wash or sanitise your hands before you are seated for your appointment. Hand sanitizer will also be available to you throughout the trial and you are encouraged to use it.

During your appointment if you really need to sneeze or cough please do this into a tissue provided and bin the tissue immediately after use, then wash your hands.

I will be wearing a face visor, mask and gloves during the appointment. I will also not be wearing any jewellery as this could harbour bacteria. If you wear a nose piercing please remove this prior to your visit and ideally any other jewellery.

Surfaces, tools and makeup will all be thoroughly disinfected and cleaned using Barbicide, Dettol, Isopropyl alcohol and The Pro Hygiene Collection products thoroughly before, during and after your appointment. Disposable applicators will be used to apply products such as mascara as well as other disposables where possible.

Should you wish me to use any of your own makeup or tools these will also be sanitised before and after use.

Unfortunately hot drinks will not be provided for the foreseeable future. I will provide you with a bottle of water, please take this away with you.

Covid-19 Hygiene Update for Weddings/Events/Occasions

Please be aware 10-15 minutes additional time will now be required before and after every client to thoroughly disinfect, clean and sanitise work surfaces, tools and makeup. Wedding Day schedules I send out to Brides going forward will reflect these changes.

Please wash your hair within 24 hours of the appointment with me.

I will require a well-ventilated room with only one client at a time in the room with me.

As with trials I will be wearing a visor, mask and gloves. These will be cleaned and changed between clients and I will be wearing no jewellery. I will have hand sanitizer and tissues available for you to use.

Please wash/sanitise your hands before your appointment with me.

If you wear a nose piercing please remove this prior to make up application.

During your appointment if you really need to sneeze or cough please do this into a tissue provided and bin the tissue immediately after use. Please wash your hands.

I will carry a disposable rubbish bag with me on the day.

I will not be carrying my makeup chair to homes and venues for the foreseeable future.

If you or anyone you have been in contact with has COVID-19 symptoms please respectfully cancel your appointment with me before or on the day.

I am also an Asthmatic, in a higher risk category therefore taking every precaution necessary.
